Lisa is a consultant orthodont dentist. Having qualified at Dundee in 1996, she went into hospital training and spent VTs at general practice in Edinburgh before working at home for several years. Lisa became a specialist orthodont dentist in 2003, trained consultants at Birmingham Dental Hospital and Stoke-on-Trent, and became a consultant orthodont dentist in 2006. She also has a master's degree in sleep apnea and is an honorary senior lecturer at Aberdeen Dental Hospital. Lisa first joined the correctional clinic in 2010. Ivin is the managing director of practice. She was originally from Malaysia and owned several design and printing businesses. Lisa and Ivin acquired the clinic in July 2014 and moved their business to a new site in September 2018. Tell us about your new practice the building is four stories high. In the basement, there is a staff room, lab and lecture room, which provides in-house tutorials and postgraduate training. The first floor is our clinical floor. There is a reception area and waiting room, as well as six dental chairs. There are two enclosed private surgeries and four semi-open plan surgeries separated by glass panels. We have another X-ray chamber that accommodates digital OPT/ceph machines and our LDU is at this level. It accommodates two large, washing machine disinfectors under the bench. There is a management space on the first floor. Includes a large open-plan office with space for bookkeeping and other administrative tasks, and a hot desk for nurses. As well as Lisa and Ivin's offices, there is a separate meeting room. The top floor is used for storage. Our equipment includes 4 autoclaves, a water purifier system and 2 large compressors (1 regular backup and 1 backup). We are in the process of securing an intraoral scanner that should be with us soon. Tell us that your staff and specialties, Dr. Lisa Curry and Dr. Daria Rodolino, are professional orthodontians. There are two orthodontic therapists who can adjust the braces (based on a prescription from the clinician) and perform fittings. The team includes part-time GDP, eight fully qualified dental nurses and full-time lab technicians. There are two full-time receptionists and two administrative staff. Have you noticed a change in the popularity of the services we offer? We provide tooth whitening services and Lisa's expertise in sleep apnea means she can treat snoring problems with patients with this condition and bespoke anti-snoring devices. We are seeing a growing demand for corrective services and more aesthetic treatments. What prompted you to open this practice? It was a floor and four-chair practice - we were struggling to meet the increasing demand. Even if we wanted to hire more people, there was no place to put them. The move was one that gave us more space and future practice. It gives us the possibility to expand our team as needed. Tell us about the communities you serve In this part of the country, we are lucky that people are ready to travel for treatment. There are patients from as far a distance as Aberdeenshire, Morayshire and Inverness Shire. Does that building have an interesting history? Before we moved in, the building was divided into different suites occupied by oil sector companies and very close to the previous location that was in Golden Square. We were only intentionally available for a short distance. We've been looking for a new facility for a year or two and when this building came on we thought it was perfect. Located just behind Aberdeen Music Hall, it's easy to remember and there are a lot of people on the pass. How was the planning process and financial security? Among other things, we had to apply for a change of use. Ivin has a background in design as well as business, and came up with his first idea of how to optimally shape a building to meet his needs. In the mean time, we had a good architect who helped us plan. We had to apply for a business mortgage to buy the building, but apart from that everything was self-funded. What renovations and structural changes were needed? We needed to completely reform the interior of the building, but thankfully we don't have to break down load-bearing walls and other major structural changes. Of course, we had to make the building suitable for disabled people and it was period property, so we had to make sure we worked with proper consent. The process went a little over time, but everything was relatively easy. How long did the whole process take? There were no major hurdles along the way. We didn't hire a project manager, so we had to oversee the whole process while taking care of the business. We didn't have an outside life for 18 months, so now that we're enjoying life with the new practice, it's even more satisfying! These are based on topical themes and can be cut out in the day's practice or, if necessary, staff skill-based training. Lisa lectures at the dental hospital, so there is a good bank of materials and clinical cases that can be dipped. Most of our nurses are trained to impress Completed the X-ray photography course. One has undert been trained as a specialist orthodontic nurse. We like our staff to focus on CPD. Every year we take almost every team to the British Orthodontic Conference to pay for attendance, travel and accommodation - which I feel is important to keep up to date with the current thinking of the specialty and encourage camarism and team building. We have spent the years winning several awards, supported by our philosophy that the team is our best asset. Do you have facilities dedicated to employees? Among other things, we have created a huge staff room overlooking the enclosed courtyard. Staff can get out there for breaks if needed. There is a separate staff toilet and shower room, everyone has their own locker and we have two parking spaces that rotate between the staff. Is there a patient-only facility? We believe it is obvious as soon as you go inside. We have introduced a self-check-in system that simplifies the practicality of patients. The waiting room is very comfortable. As far as the treatment room is concerned, we chose to have a range of furniture manufacturing tops and high quality Belmont Voyager chairs - all aspects were taken into account. Lisa's surgery has a two-seater sofa, so if you treat a young person, your parents can join the session if they want to have it on hand. How do you explain the spirit of practice? The awards we have won are based on being the best team and the best pro year. We know that successful practice depends on having a happy, highly trained, professional and inspired staff. When patients come to see us, they can see that there is a positive atmosphere and this is a great place to work. It's also unusual for a consultant-trained orthodont dentist like Lisa to work full-time. It gives us a different level of experience and exclusivity. What were our personal challenges and how to overcome them? But it was too much fun because I knew what the final product was. The big challenges were time management and contractor coordination. It was especially tough because we had to practice at the same time. The secret to success was a lot of careful planning and real passion for this project, promising a great place for all of our team to work. What do you enjoy about what you're practicing? As soon as we entered the first day, there was a great space, comfort and luxury. I think everyone is delighted with the new habit - in particular, people are looking around with their families in. We are very proud of it. Now that we're calm, our immediate focus is Development - We are determined to make the most of this cutting-edge practice for the benefit of our team and patients. Patients.
